>>> USCIS GREEN CARD INTERVIEW UPDATE

Last interview for people we serve was in November 2025

USCIS appears to have started scheduling Green Card interviews again. One family we support recently checked their case status online and received a message indicating that they should receive their interview notice by mail soon. Families who are waiting for their interviews should continue checking their mail regularly and monitor their USCIS case status using the receipt number from their Form I-797C (Notice of Action).
