New Jersey-based Tropical Cheese Industries has acquired Pineland Farms Dairy Company in Bangor, Maine's largest cheese producer.

Tropical Cheese, which specializes in Latin American foods, produces a wide range of cheeses as well as meats. The company plans to make Bangor its second major cheese manufacturing location while keeping the current team and existing customer and supplier relationships in place. The facility sources milk from farmers within 50 miles of Bangor, supporting local dairy farms and Maine's agricultural economy.
