Bangor's Together Place closed its daytime drop-in center and meal program on July 31 after failing to raise enough funds to replace a lost state grant. While some recovery support programs will continue, the closure leaves many people experiencing homelessness, mental health challenges, and substance use disorders without an important daytime resource.
