>>> CHANGES TO THE BUS SYSTEM

New fixed-stop system and app

Last week the Community connector switched to a fixed-stop system. Bus riders won't be able to flag down a bus at any point in the route anymore. Buses will only be picking up people at fixed stops. The system has also introduced a free smartphone app called Bangor Community Connector, which allows riders to track buses in real time and view estimated arrival times at each stop.
