IMPACT OF GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN <<<

USCIS is still processing cases

With the Federal Government shutdown, we have had families wondering if the cases they have pending with USCIS were still being processed. USCIS is almost entirely funded by fees paid by immigrants, U.S. citizens, and employers paying for applications. This largely insulates USCIS from shutdowns and permits most of the agency to continue to operate as normal. Application interviews, naturalization ceremonies, biometrics processing, and similar parts of the legal immigration system should remain unchanged during the shutdown.
